ELIGIBILITY

1. All projects must be located, constructed, and completed, between January 2005 and September 2008, in the state of Tennessee.
2. More than one entry may be submitted by an architect or architectural firm.
3. Masonry (brick, block, stone, tile, glass block) must be the predominant material used in the project.
4. Entries must meet all rules of this competition in order to be considered for an award.

ENTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Download or request template. Visit www.masonryinsttn.com and download the PowerPoint template "Excellence in Masonry 2009 Template." If there is any trouble downloading the template, e-mail mit@masonryinsttn.com with "Excellence in Masonry Template Request" as the subject. The PowerPoint template will be e-mailed to you in return.
2. Complete and return the PowerPoint template including pictures of the following:
 - A. Site plan (a scanned rendering is acceptable)
 - B. Floor plan(s)
 - C. Exterior elevations
 - D. Interior masonry (if pertinent)
 - E. Featured masonry details
 - F. 2-5 pictures of the project (one of which *must* be a black and white digital photo).
3. The completed PowerPoint template should contain pictures from above (A through F). The total number of slides submitted should not exceed 12. All images placed in the template should also be saved in a separate folder.
4. Completed template and folder of images may be saved and returned by mail or in person on a CD or 100MB Zip disk. Please label the CD or disk with your company name and name of the structure. Include your entry form with the CD or disk.
